Ola,

I asked Josh to sign my Authorization of Premium Compensation, DS-3060 form this morning.

He has refused stating that: "I work hours off the clock all the time, you should only be getting overtime for extraordinary events such as the courier run and special projects. When you take a long lunch or spend time conversing with other employees—that's personal time and you need to work extra to make up for that."

I eat my meals in the embassy foyer along with other employees, I eat in a timely fashion similarly to the other employees. No other employees have noted me taking a longer time period than that which is usual and allowable to other post personnel. I have no personal items in the embassy on which I might spend personal time. I follow his guidance in regards to e-mail usage. When I am in the embassy I am working.

For several time periods after my arrival at post I worked side by side with Josh while he encouraged me to "show him what I could do" while he signed, and encouraged me to submit, false DS-3060 forms that failed to account for all of the time that we spent working together in the embassy. There are numerous safe and door logs, two examples being: the IPC safe door entry log and the main embassy entrance log, that document our working time together in the embassy.

Please assist me in verifying that my supervisor, Josh Hromatka, is submitting false DS-3060s and is requiring his subordinates to do the same.
