1. Action request in paragraph 4.

2. Preparations are under way for convening the Spring Session of the SPTB, which will review the performance files of specialist candidates for conferral of tenure, on March 24, 2010. This message is to alert posts about candidates scheduled for review in order to ensure that required evaluation reports are submitted promptly and to invite any correction to the list of candidates eligible for review (PARA 6). JCOMs and/or management officers are asked to oversee this process closely so that evaluation reports are submitted on time (see PARA 4). Please remember that late reports are a serious disservice to candidates under consideration and could disadvantage them.

3. The Spring Session of the SPTB will consider the following candidates (A) All specialist candidates who as of February 1, 2010 had two years experience in the Service from date of appointment and have been previously promoted to the highest possible level under the administrative process, if appointed below the PS-34 level. (B) All specialists in the medical occupation categories who as of February 1, 2010 had three years experience in the Service from date of appointment and have been previously promoted to the highest possible level under the administrative process. (C) All specialist career candidates who were not tenured on their first review by the 2009 Spring SPTB.

4. An evaluation report must be prepared on form SS-1829, if by February 1, 2010, 120 days or more had elapsed since a report was last submitted. Rating officers may consider preparing a voluntary memorandum of performance for periods less than 120 days, however, this is strictly optional. The evaluation report must be prepared in accordance with the provisions of 3 FAM 2250. In addition, those eligible candidates who serve in active military duty are encouraged to submit military evaluations and a separate rated employee's statement for each military evaluation. The original EER must arrive in HR/PE, addressed to the attention of Lisa A. Johnson, Columbia Plaza, 2401 E Street, NW, Washington, DC 20522, no later than March 19, 2010. Please remember that late reports are a disservice to candidates under consideration and could disadvantage them. If post is unable to submit a report by diplomatic pouch or express mail in time to meet the deadline, scanned copies by email or fax may be provided.

5. Paragraph 6 lists those candidates who, according to HR/PE's records, will be eligible for tenure review. HR/PE would appreciate posts confirming immediately the assignment of the candidates and stating whether an evaluation report will be submitted. If post is not submitting an evaluation report, please explain why. If a candidate has been transferred, please advise onward assignment. PLEASE NOTE that posts from which a candidate has been transferred may still be responsible for submission of the report.
