The holding of my HHE and UAB is both a reprisal for contending my age discrimination complaint and constitutes coercion by a supervisor over an untenured trainee. This is illegal.

You and the shipping contractor have not responded to my last 4 e-mails requesting the status and location of my UAB.

If you are holding my UAB because I failed to complete the required checkout procedure--please be informed that Josh's insistence that I sign off on less than the full amount of overtime due me was coercive on his part and that by withholding my UAB you are engaged in a reprisal against me for filing an age discrimination complaint.

If you sent it to New Zealand by mistake I will forgive and forget--but I need to know now so I can buy a printer and try to recover the information in my motel room.

Here is Mr. Harrison's response:

Marvin's things are being held because he failed to check out of post or leave a final payer to cover his bills, any damage claims, lost items etc. (I've attached a copy of the initial e-mail exchange wherein I explained the situation to him.)

NOT SEEN UNTIL THIS MESSAGE SEPT 2.

I followed the embassy provided checklist which I have
This would void my complaint

On the day Marvin was to leave post he didn't come to the embassy to check out, sign off on HR documents, return embassy equipment or any of the other procedures normally associated with checking out of post. I called him as did his direct supervisor and the management officer and he refused to come in. I subsequently checked with HR and was advised that I could hold his things pending payment for things such as phone usage, fuel, and damaged items. I'm currently waiting to see if there is a final phone bill. Despite Marvin's protest I've already received a final fuel bill and he is liable for damage to a dining room table as well. I can send those bills to him now and take the chance that he didn't use the phone if you advise. I'd then release his things on receipt of his payment.

I am also attaching an email change between you and Mr. Harrison which he included in his response. Please let me know if you have additional information regarding this.

MY APARTMENT WAS INSPECTED BY MR. HARRISON'S EMPLOYEE LATE JUNE AND NO DAMAGE TO THE DINNING ROOM TABLE WAS NOTED. I DEMAND MY \$300+ BACK THAT HE COERLED ME INTO PAYING HIM.
